## DENTAL OLYMPICS BASKETBALL

Events: Men's Women's

## Format:

- 1. Two men's team and one women's team per school.
- 2. Single elimination
- 3. There will be two (2) twenty minute halves with a five minute break between halves.
- 4. The clock will run continuously, stopping for time outs or shooting fouls ONLY in the last two minutes of the SECOND half (i.e. 2 shot fouls or 1 on 1 fouls).
- 5. Two time outs allowed per team per half. 1<sup>st</sup> half time outs will not carry over to second half. Time out periods will be 2 minutes.
- 6. If three point line exists, it can be utilized. If fouled in the act of shooting a 3 point, and if missed, 3 foul shots will be awarded.
- 7. Overtime period(s), if needed, will be five minutes long, clock will follow same as during regulation time.
- 8. There will be a tip off to begin regulation and overtime period, then possession rules will apply to jump ball situations. Personal foul total and team foul totals will continue into overtime period(s); therefore, a player that has fouled out cannot resume play in overtime period(s) and if 1 on 1 situation is in effect in regulation time, it will be in effect in overtime.
- 9. Each team will have one time out per overtime period.
- 10. If more than one overtime period is needed, there will be a two minute break between overtimes.
- 11. Officials will be present at all games.
- 12. Each player has a total of five personal fouls before he/she is considered "fouled out".
- 13. NCAA rules apply to all other situations.
- 14. All players participating must be on a roster. Rosters must be given to opponents team captains before start of play, and should be checked along with student ID. An individual player cannot be on a roster for both teams.
