

Dental Olympics Golf Rules

Twelve Players from each school will compete, each school comprising of six teams of two. The format will be as follows:

The 18 hole match will consist of six holes best ball, six holes scramble, and six holes alternate shot.

Best Ball - Each player will play his or her own ball through the first six holes. The score taken for the team will be the low score between the two players for each hole. You may play the ball "up" (moving the ball for a better lie) in the rough and in the fairway, not to move your ball more than a grips length. If your ball is in the rough, it remains in the rough.

Scramble - Each player will drive a ball off the tee. The best shot will be selected and both players will hit from that spot and so forth. If the ball is in the rough it remains in the rough, if the ball is on the fringe, it remains on the fringe not to be moved onto the green.

Alternate Shot - Each player will drive the ball off each tee. Alternate shot will proceed through the green. You may play the ball "up" at all times, not to move the ball more than a grips length and not to be moved out of that cut of grass.

All course rules will be in effect. There will be no mulligans, and no gimmies on the green. You must putt the ball out. If you ball goes out of bounds or in a water hazard the appropriate penalty will be in effect. Each foursome will consist of two teams from different schools. This will help minimize score discrepancies.

There will be nine tee times on that morning. It is necessary to be on time, approximately 8:30am.
