

DENTAL OLYMPICS WASHERS

Events: 2 person teams

Format:

1. There will be a maximum of four teams from each school. They can be men's women's or co-ed.
2. 2" washers will be used.
3. Cups will be centered in the washer pits level with the surface of the pit. The appropriate size of the cup will allow the washer to enter the cup freely with less than 3mm on all sides.
4. Pits will be 2' wide by 3' long.
5. Front edges of cups will be placed 21' apart.
6. The first team to 21 points wins.
7. Alternating throws of 5 washers per team will be volleyed.
8. Ringers equal 5 points, leaners 3 points, and closest to the hole (in the case of no ringers or leaners) will score one point each. Closest to the hole could award as much as 5 points to a team on any given series if the other team doesn't land on the pit. In the event of multiple ringers, the team whose washer is on top is awarded 5 points. A team may be awarded multiple ringers as long as the opposing team is not covering their washer.
9. At least five washers need to be colored on both sides in order to identify the team.
10. Matches will be played in order as they appear on the bracket, within reason. If a washer competitor is in the middle of another sport all possible efforts will be made to allow the team to compete, e.g. move down the bracket as far as possible before disqualifying a team.
11. All players participating must be on a roster. Rosters must be given to opponents team captains before start of play, and should be checked with student ID. An individual player cannot be on a roster for more than one team.
